1. Ironstone Walk @ Aarschot

Take a walk through the rust-coloured ironstone accentuated countryside. O Make sure to taste a Hageland wine after your walk.

2. Big Oak Walk @ Bierbeek

Head into Meerdaal Forest from the centre of Bierbeek. Over 1,000 majestic big oaks (with trunks over 2.5 metres around) await.

3. Ter Rijst Walk @ Pepingen

This park is a romantic's dream come true with arch bridges, elegant old trees, and gorgeous vistas. When in bloom, the bluebells, wood anemones, and wild daffodils dapple the park with colour.
